

**"THE BROOKLYN RAIL: SELECTION 1,"**

Wythe Studio, 240 Wythe Avenue, at North Third Street, Williamsburg, Brooklyn, (718) 349-8427 (through Monday). Anyone in the market for a snapshot view of what can now be considered the mainstream Williamsburg scene will do well to visit this group show of resident talent. Organized by Phong Bui, an artist and publisher of *The Brooklyn Rail*, a smart, bimonthly arts-tabloid, much of the work has been gathered from leading neighborhood galleries and installed in a space donated for the occasion (through Monday, noon to 6 p.m.) by Weeve Projects, a local developer. In roundups like this, with some 60 artists, none get to look their very best, but the overall feeling is lively and the mix is good. Among the highlights in the exhibition are first-rate paintings by Jane Fine, Glen Goldberg, Yun Fei-jin, Eric Heist and **Larry Mullins**; installations by Marilla Palmer and Andy Yoder; and a riotous consumerist video by Michael Ballou (Cotter).
